**READING PARKING AUTHORITY –  
MULTIPLE CONTRACTS POLICY**

*The following shall constitute the Multiple Contracts Policy of the Reading Parking Authority, duly adopted by its Board of Directors on October 27, 2020:*

WHEREAS, the Board of the Reading Parking Authority (“Authority”) desires to assure that all of its professional service providers are above reproach and desires to avoid even the appearance of impropriety; and

WHEREAS, for purposes hereof, professional service providers shall include the Authority Solicitor, its Auditor, its Executive Director and other professionals and/or consultants it may retain from time-to-time.

NOW, THEREFORE, incorporating the recitals above, the Authority adopts the following policy regarding its professional service providers:

No professional service provider to the Authority shall have any ownership interest in, or be an employee, director or officer of, any company providing services to the Authority for compensation outside of his, her or its primary position with the Authority.

This policy shall take effect immediately upon its adoption this 27<sup>th</sup> day of October 2020.
